I have lived in Eastwood for 50 years and have represented the residents of Eastwood for over 20 years, addressing your individual concerns and wider Ward and Borough issues, most recently:

- Represented you in on-line consultations on the demolition of our gas holders and the alleviation of flooding in Progress Road and the problems of Eastwood brook
- Successfully opposed a larger telecommunication mast proposed at Rochford Corner (double the size of the existing mast)
- Successfully lobbied for a right turn lane into Lidl's car park
- I continue to attend the Local Community Meetings with the Police to discuss crime in Eastwood, these meetings replace the Leigh Crime Prevention Panel, of which I was a member for over a decade
- I actively support the environment and campaign for new trees in suitable places


