- We will: Retain a weekly waste collection service for all residents and increase recycling rates across the city.

- We will: Plant new trees and shrubs and maintain our parkland and grass verges.
- We will: Clean our street signs and replace broken signs and railings promptly to improve our street scene.

- We will: Ensure that the Jazz Centre UK will remain at the Beecroft Gallery.
- We will: Protect our conservation areas across the city and ensure all issues in the Garrison Conservation Area are resolved

Improving our transport and **keeping Southend moving...**

- We will: Stop the closure of the Queensway road Underpass to avoid the predicted chaos in the city.
- We will: Scrap the planned use of £10 Million of public money for the economically unviable Seaway Car Park scheme.
- We will: End the anti-car policies of the current Administration and create more seafront parking.
- We will: Fill every pot hole reported to the Council and invest in our roads and footpaths.
- We will: Provide cheaper parking by scrapping the 6pm-9pm charges on the seafront and the transaction fee for using the parking app.
- We will: Improve signage to all major destinations and attractions in the city and erect new signage to signpost visitors to our beaches.
- We will: Never install speed humps in residential roads without full consultation and the support of local residents.
- We will: Create segregated cycle paths to join the whole of the seafront and support the safe passing of cyclists campaign.
- We will: Scrap all plans for 15 minute/low traffic neighbourhoods where planters block roads or fines are issued for leaving our neighbourhood.
- We will: Continue to oppose the 85,000 mud trucks using our roads to deliver soil to the Gunners Park development.

Ensuring a decent home for everyone...

- We will: Make sure that all our Council housing stock continues to meet the Decent Homes Standard.
- We will: Never support inappropriate development and we will ensure all developments have appropriate infrastructure.
- We will: Require all new Council built homes to be carbon neutral.
- We will: Invest all right to buy receipts into building new Council housing.
- We will: Continue to build more Council housing and affordable homes in appropriate areas.



Bringing life and vibrancy back to the High Street...

- We will: Put free car parking in roads off the High Street by removing unnecessary vellow lines.
- We will: Remove the barriers within the Council that prevent businesses from investing in the High Street and our city.
- We will: Create an environment that attracts quality shops and business to the area and make the High Street a place people want to come to.
- We will: Make the High Street a 'go to' and safe destination and environment.
- We will: Bid for Government funding and grants to improve the High Street.
- We will: Develop long term plans for the Council owned Victoria Shopping Centre.

Creating a safer Southend by improving community safety...

- We will: Give powers to the Police and Council Officers to tackle anti-social behaviour across the city.
- We will: Expand the Community Safety Team with volunteers and provide full training and equipment.
- We will: Restore the broken relationship between the Council and the Police.
- We will: Take action to stop the constant illegal traveller encampments.
- We will: Consult with the city's traders and businesses on any road closures on the seafront for crime and anti-social behaviour reasons.
